The Town of Truckee notified NTTHS that they are not in code compliance with the 2016 Minor Use Permit issued for the site. There is a gap in funding as a result of COVID Federal funding going away. There was discussion about calling the Church of the Mountains a temporary vs permanent location. Those in the group who felt it should be temporary stated the need to remind stakeholders of the need for a permanent location. Those in the group who felt it should not be stated as temporary pointed out that the permit would then be in effect longer-term and therefore not needed to be modified again down the road. Process: 1. Update permit to reflect current programs; 2. Submit letter to the Planning Council; 3. Appeal to the Town Council.
